2018-2019 Cove School Yearbook Cover Design Contest is on! All entries are due by 3pm on Friday, October 26th and voting will take place at lunch time on Friday, November 2nd. The winner will be announced in June. The winning design will appear on the front of the yearbook and the winner will receive a free yearbook. All entries will be featured somewhere in the yearbook. This year's theme is: "**Reach for the Stars**" - **It's not enough to wish on stars, you have to reach for them. So go out, aim high, spread your wings and fly. You never know what you can do until you try!**

Yearbook Cover Contest Rules:

- (1) Eligibility: The Yearbook Cover contest is open **only to 5th grade students**.
- (2) **Original student artwork only**. Any artwork that depicts copyrighted images will be rejected. For example, no artworks depicting characters from television shows, movies, video games, or books will be accepted. All artwork must be original ideas and created entirely by the student.
- (3) Submit only **one entry per student**. Students may choose to work in teams (*Note: if the team's entry is chosen as the winner, the team will receive only one free yearbook*).
- (4) All submissions must be **8 ½ x 11 inches and must use a vertical orientation**.



- (5) Any of the following media or techniques may be used:
 - Paint (watercolor, tempera, poster, acrylic, etc.)
 - Drawing materials (charcoal, pastels, markers, or crayons – *Note: colored pencils are not recommended, since they are difficult to reproduce.*)
 - Collage materials (cut and glued papers, such as construction paper, tissue paper, wrapping paper, aluminum foil, etc.)
 - Prints (handmade stencils, gadget printing, block prints, etc.)
 - Original digital illustration
 - Original photography
- (6) ***Write your name(s) and teacher's name in pencil **on the back** of your entry.
